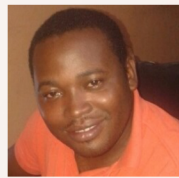

Abiodun Solanke from Nigeria. Abiodun is a licensed architect who is interested in using bamboo as a low-cost building material for housing communities in Nigeria.



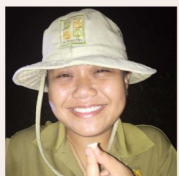
Adam Wasiak from Poland. Adam is the Senior Advisor to the Directorate General of State Forests in Poland. He is interested in state-level forestry planning and operations.
